Constitution

The VITA is the national authority of time trial records for its members of forty years old and over, irrespective of the area in which the events are

All VTTA events are fully open to Veterans and shall be conducted in accordance with RTTC or SCU regulations.

The Association will recognise, hallmark and issue record certificates to members only at all distances from 10 miles to 24 hours for best performance in Open, Semi-open and Association events at all ages.

Awards, Records and Competitions

The following awards, records and competitions are open to all members of the Association. Qualifying events for all of these are any Open, Semi-open or

Association event which appears in the current RTTC or SCU Handbooks.

Records and standards are awarded for rides on solo and tandem bicycles and for rides on solo and tandem tricycles.

Standard Awards

Standard medals will be awarded for 10 miles, 25 miles, 30 miles, 50 miles, 100 miles, 12 hours and 24 hours rides. Initially the rider must beat his standard as shown in the VTTA Standard Tables. In subsequent years he must beat his previous performance by a bigger margin.

Age Records

Age Record certificates are awarded for rides in all events on the road from 10 miles to 24 hours. Records are also recognised for both indoor and outdoor track performances at various distances from 5 kms to 100 kms. No record will be considered if a better time or distance has already been achieved by a record holder of greater age.

Competitions

Three Distance Competition

This annual competition is held over 25, 50 and 100 miles. The formula for deciding the competition is the rider's time when compared with his time as shown in the VTTA Standard Tables, i.e. aggregated plus minutes and seconds.

Best All Rounder Competition

This annual competition is held over 25, 50, 100 miles and 12 hours. The formula for deciding the competition is the rider's time or distance calculated in mph when compared with his standards as shown in the VITA Standard Tables calculated in mph.
